

M.C.A.C. Championship Regulations

The Club Championship year will run from 1st December to 30th November the following year.

QUALIFICATION:

Only DULY ELECTED and FULLY PAID UP Club Members may score points and they must be members at the time of presentation. To qualify for points and awards members MUST:

- a) Display MCAC stickers on the car;
- b) Claim points as soon as possible after the event and no later than one month after the results are published, by passing a copy of the entry/starters list and final results to the Championship Secretary. At the end of the championship year, the final date for claiming points is 24th December;
- c) Write a contribution for the magazine;
- d) Marshalled/organised on a MCAC organised event or have scored organizing/marshalling points on at least one event in the appropriate category.

ELIGIBLE EVENTS:

- a) Events organized by MCAC;
- b) Events to which MCAC are invited;
- c) Championship rounds of ACSMC, AEMC, LCAMC or WAMC;
- d) Any National 'A' or International event.

ANNUAL AWARDS:

To qualify for awards 1 to 9, a member must have scored organizing/marshalling points on at least one event in the appropriate category, or organized/marshalled on any MCAC event (of any category).

| 1 BELL TROPHY | Leading Driver - All events. To qualify for this award a member must have scored points as a driver in at least two categories of events.
The winner is not eligible for awards 3-6. |
| 2 NAPSPEED TROPHY | Leading Navigator - All events. To qualify for this award a member must have scored points as a co-driver/navigator in at least two categories of events.
The winner is not eligible for awards 7-9. |
| 3 STEPHENS TROPHY | Best Driver competing in off road events. |
| 4 ALEXANDER TROPHY | Best Road Rally Driver. |
| 5 KENSINGTON CUP | Best Stage Rally Driver. |
| 6 OAKES CUP | Best Night Trial Driver. |
| 7 GAMAGE CUP | Best Road Rally Navigator. |
| 8 SOUTHGATE CUP | Best Stage Rally Co-Driver. |
| 9 LAWSON CUP | Best Night Trial Navigator. |
| 10 JUBILEE CUP | Member scoring most Clubman points for marshalling on events |
| 11 FINCHLEY CUP | Member scoring most Clubman points for servicing on events. |
| 12 CENTENARY CUP | Member scoring most Clubman points for organising events. |
| 13 CORONATION CUP | Most Active Club Member. One point will be awarded to every person involved in an event - marshals, organizers and competitors. The recipient may not be a winner of any of the trophies 1 to 12 above. |
| 14 LADIES CUP | Best Lady, providing that she has competed in at least three events. All points, however scored, can be counted towards this award. If Best Lady is eligible for one of the above awards, the Ladies Cup will be awarded to the second Lady, provided that she has also scored points by competing in at least three events. |
| 15 NORMAN TIPPING MEMORIAL CUP | Member COMPETING in most events regardless of how successful.
Receipt of this award does not debar member from being awarded one of the other awards. |
| 16 MIDDLESEX CHALLENGE SHIELD | To the winner of the Middlesex Challenge. (NB Separate rules) |

OTHER AWARDS

The following awards are presented on a discretionary basis by the Council/President as appropriate.

| POXON AWARD | To the member who in the opinion of the Council has made the most sportsman-like contribution in the year. |
| PRESIDENT'S AWARD | To the member(s) who, in the opinion of the President, has contributed most to the Club during the year. |
| BEST NEWCOMER | If warranted the Council will make an award to the Best Newcomer to the sport. |
| BENGT ARMCO AWARD | To the member involved in the silliest non-competitive accident. |

Points System

COMPETITORS CHAMPIONSHIP

Points will be awarded to Competitors in the following manner, providing that their club is shown as MCAC on the entry list and they do not compete in an event in the name of another Club (note GR E7.1.2).
For awards 3 to 9 above, competitors may only count their best 10 scores in any category.

ALL EVENTS: (Classes as per SRs for the event)

The formula is:

(Number of STARTERS in Class - Your POSITION in Class) + 1 Point

PLUS bonus of 5 points for winning Class
bonus of 3 points for 2nd in Class
bonus of 1 point for 3rd in Class.

You will be awarded 1 point if you retire. No additional points for beating other MCAC crews.

PLUS A bonus of 5 points for winning the event
A bonus of 3 points for 2nd overall
A bonus of 1 point for 3rd overall.

EVENT COEFFICIENT

Multiply the sum of all points above by the following event status coefficient

Closed, Clubman's and National B (or a 1 day) Events	1.0
National A (or 2 day) Events	1.5
International (or 3 day) Events	2.0

DEFINITION

Closed, Clubman and National B Events:-

An event where the highest level of licence required to compete is a National B

National A:-

An event where the lowest level of licence required to compete is a National A

International:-

An event that is entered on the International Calendar and is open to competitors and drivers of various nationalities.

NON COMPETITORS CHAMPIONSHIP:

a) SERVICING:

Points will be awarded for bona-fide crews servicing for a MCAC member on eligible events when servicing is permitted (the appropriate category of event will be decided by the Championship Secretary):-

One day stage rallies, autocross and rallycross events	2 points.
Medium length events (such as a BRC Round/2 day	4 points.
Long Event (such as WRC Round/event over 2 days	6 points.

b) ORGANISING:

Points will be awarded for organizing events on behalf of MCAC according to the following:-

All events where a MSA Permit is issued:-

Officials involved with pre-event planning	4 points
Officials on the day	2 points

NOTE:- Where the same person performs a number of roles on an event, only one set of points will be awarded.

c) MARSHALLING:

<i>All marshals on any event</i>	<i>2 points/day</i>

AWARDS FOR INDIVIDUAL EVENTS

As in previous years, some of the permanent MCAC trophies will be awarded to the best placed full member(s) on certain other events, subject to there being at least FOUR ELIGIBLE MCAC CREWS starting the event.

Exceptionally, the Powysbrooke Trophy will be awarded to the Best eligible MCAC Crew on the Wales Rally GB or similar status event regardless of the number of MCAC starters.

The crew winning the Best MCAC Award are responsible for the submission of a contribution to the Club Magazine about the event, but this may be written by anyone (i.e. NO contribution about the event, NO award, so if you're the Best MCAC either submit one or make sure one is written!).
