

Middlesex County Automobile Club Privacy Policy

(Last updated April 2018)

We believe in keeping safe any information you give us and we take appropriate security measures to safeguard your privacy. We follow strict security procedures on how your personal information is stored and used but, as no system is 100% secure, we can't completely guarantee the protection of your personal information any more than any other organisation can. Therefore, we can't accept any liability for the loss, theft or misuse of your personal details when they are processed on this website or the internet generally. We are registered with the Information Commissioner's Office and comply with all current data protection laws. This policy describes how we collect, process and look after the information you provide us with when you visit our site.

We will never share with a third party the information you provide except:

- We reserve the right to release necessary details to the emergency services, our insurers or event organiser in the event of an accident.
- We may publish the entry lists and/or results of our events on our website and supply this information to competitors and other championship coordinators. We supply only very basic details that may include your name, home town, your car make & model and the times achieved during the event. We will never release more specific personal information without your permission.
- If we are obliged by law

We will never directly ask you to give us any financial information such as bank or payment card details.

Information we may hold:

When you join the club or enter one of our events or championship, we will ask you to complete and submit a form, either in paper format or online that contains personal information about you. This may include (but may not be limited to) information such as your first and last name, postal address, telephone number, e-mail address, details of someone to be contacted in an emergency, details of your driving experience and other personal information. We will store your information in a secure manner on

www.membermojo.co.uk/mcac exclusively for MCAC use. We collect this information in order to record and support your membership of the Club, your event entry, or your championship registration, and to let you know about events that we believe you may be interested in, as a participant, a spectator or as a marshal. We will use the information you provide to keep you informed about the Club, its activities and its services.

So that we can accurately record progress of participants in our Championship, we receive event results from other event organisers. This information is not used by us for any other purpose and is accepted in the belief that it is accurate and that you have authorised the sender to supply it to us.

We do not automatically collect any personal information about you when you use our website and we do not use any trackers.

Our website contains links to the websites of other organisations. We do not have any control over these websites so please refer to their privacy policies if you decide to follow one of the links.

Data Processing Statement:

In accordance with latest General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR) the information you give us will be used only for the purpose of running Middlesex County Automobile Club and its activities. You will only receive communications from us that are relevant to your membership, our Championship, the events you enter or other events that we believe might be of interest to you. Other than as detailed above, we will never release your personal details to another club or third party without first obtaining your permission.

It is vital that we hold personal data so that we can run our motorsport events and our Championship and keep you informed about the Club's activities. Without this information we would be unable to run our events, or indeed the club for its members. We consider we have a 'legitimate interest' in the information we hold about our members, volunteers and those who participate in our events and/or Championship. You may object to us holding information about you, but in doing so will result in us having to decline your entry/booking for our event(s) and/or our Championship as we are obliged by the sport's governing body (the MSA) or our insurers to obtain and retain such personal information.

For the purpose of GDPR, Middlesex County Automobile Club is both the data controller and data processor, and can be contacted via the [Contact Us](#) page of our website.

GDPR grants you the right to access particular personal data that we hold concerning you. If you request access, we shall respond promptly and certainly within one month from receipt of your request and all necessary information from you. If you inform us that we hold any inaccurate personal data concerning you, we shall correct our records without undue delay.
